The Office of the Coroner, for Adams & Broomfield Counties, discourages viewing of the deceased at the Coroner facility. It is our recommendation that viewings take place in the comfort of a mortuary environment. However, the Office of the Coroner will consider requests to view the deceased, at the Office, on an individual basis. The Office of the Coroner reserves the right to deny a viewing at the Office or on scene for any reason.

Despite the above recommendations, by signing below, I choose to view the remains of the deceased referenced above. I understand that the Office of the Coroner is not a mortuary establishment and is not equipped to prepare the deceased for a viewing in the same way that a mortuary would. I understand that the remains of my loved one may be in a condition that is disturbing. I understand that viewing the remains of my loved one may cause emotional, mental, and/or physical anguish. By signing below I waive all claims which I might have against the Office of the Coroner and County for emotional, mental, and/or physical distress, or other occurrence arising out of viewing the deceased at the Office of the Coroner.
